Corn Roasters at Special Events
- New Requirement -

As of January 1, 2005, corn roasters using propane gas at special events will be required to have a burner and pilot safety shutoff device in addition to the manual shutoff valve. The safety shut-off device must be of the complete (100%) shutoff-type in order for the corn roaster to be approved for use. This requirement is to prevent the possibility of an uncontrolled discharge of propane gas during the initial lighting of the roaster as well as during its operation. Any accumulation of propane gas that can be accidentally ignited is unsafe and can result in a potential hazard to life and property. Many people visit New Mexico's Special Events.
